1. Facilitate connection

- Community collaboration incubator
 - ❖ Support community groups in their creation, development, or evolution – advice/planning and financial via LINK Community Fund
 - ❖ Use asset map for information and connection
- Create effective communication/engagement channels – eg, Connection Café
- Build community capability and partnerships – e.g., communication, relationship-building, citizenship, innovation
 - ❖ MAC Life Skills course: *Citizenship & Community Belonging* – youth engagement, civics
 - ❖ Intergenerational connection – build relationships and reduce isolation
 - ❖ Get Dotted – communication capability building
- Neighbourhood connection and placemaking

2. Facilitate action

- 3Q feedback indicates need to address the big issues – community wants to see responsibility and action taken
- Community Growth Forum for information sharing, engagement, planning, moving ideas into action
- Working with community leaders to reflect community input in decision making – eg, submitting on the 2017-18 QLDC Annual Plan and 2018-28 Long Term Plan
- Work with QLDC Community & Services Committee on district community action plan
